

## **Nominations Invited for NCURA Region II Distinguished Service Awards, 2010**

The Distinguished Service Award is an annual award to recognize members of NCURA Region II who have made sustained and significant contributions to the Region. Up to three awards may be given in any one year.

The Nominating and Membership Development Committee (NMDC) invites nominations for this award. The Awardees will be recognized at the annual Region II Spring Meeting in Princeton, NJ. The deadline for nominations is March 1, 2010. Submit a complete nomination packet, as described below, via email. The packet should be addressed to Joseph Sullivan, Region II Chair, and directed to [joseph4@andrew.cmu.edu](mailto:joseph4@andrew.cmu.edu). The Awardees will be selected by the Region II Steering Committee.

Award guidelines are:

### **Eligibility**

A candidate for the Region II Distinguished Service Award:

- Must be a current or past member of NCURA at an institution located in Region II, and
- Must have made a significant contribution to Region II.

### **Region II Distinguished Service Award -- Nomination Process**

A complete nomination packet consists of:

- A letter of nomination detailing the nominee's sustained and significant contributions to Region II of NCURA, and
- Two additional letters of support from individuals familiar with the nominee's contributions to Region II of NCURA.

Complete nomination packets must be received no later than March 1, 2010 to receive consideration for the Region II Distinguished Service Award. There will be no extensions.
